INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND TO BID

The Naval State University, Naval, Biliran, through General Appropriations Act (GAA) Fiscal Year 2017, intends to apply the sum of **(Php. 906,383.56) NINE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY THREE PESOS AND 56/100** being Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the **Construction and/or Rehabilitation of Multi – Purpose Building** in the University Main Campus. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at Bid opening.

The University bids and Awards Committee, (UBAC) now invites potential bidders/contractors registered with and classified by the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB), and a PHILGEPS Registered with Platinum Membership to apply for Eligibility and bid the herein projects:

Bidder/s shall submit a Letter of Intent and should possess a valid **PCAB License Small B Category C & D** applicable to the type and cost of the contract/s, have completed a similar contract within the last Three (3) Years from date of submission and receipt of Bids whose value, adjusted to the current price using NSO consumer indices, must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC and meet the other minimum Eligibility Requirements stated in the Eligibility Form. It must have key personnel and equipment available for the execution of the contract/project.

Applications for Eligibility will be evaluated on a non-discretionary "PASS/FAIL" basis. Only those Bidders passing the eligibility check will be entitled to purchase the Bidding Document.

Bidding will be conducted simultaneously through open and competitive bidding procedures as specified in the Revised IRR of RA 9184, otherwise known as the Government

Procurement Reform Act, and is restricted unless otherwise stated to organizations with at least Seventy-Five Percent (75%) percent interest or outstanding capital belonging to citizens of the Philippines, as specified in RA 5183. Only Bids from bidders who pass the eligibility check will be opened. The Bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) shall advance to the post-qualification stage in order to finally determine its responsiveness to the technical and financial requirements of the project. The contract shall then be awarded to the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bids, (LCRB).

All particulars relative to eligibility, bidding procedures, evaluation of bids and awards of contract shall be governed by the provisions of RA 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

A Complete set of Bid documents may be purchased by Bidders that passed the eligibility check upon presentation of the **Notice of Eligibility** to the BAC Secretariat and upon payment of a non-refundable fee in the amount of **ONE THOUSAND PESOS, (Php. 1,000.00)** for the above project to the University Cashier during Office Hours.

Eligible Bidders must submit their Bids at the address below following the schedule of Activities contained herein. All bids must be accompanied by a **BID SECURITY** in any of the acceptable forms as provided for in RA 9184 and in the amount stated in the Invitation to Apply and to bid (ITB) clause 21. Late Bids shall not be accepted.


The Naval State University will hold a Pre-Bid Conference open to all Eligible Bidders including Bid Opening on the date and time stated in the schedule at the University President's Conference Hall unless otherwise re-scheduled due to impending circumstances. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidder's authorized representatives who choose to attend.
